19. **Answer:**

The “image and likeness of God” refers to a moral likeness or a likeness of righteousness and true holiness. (Page 12)

20. **Answer:**

- (a) God is perfect, so He created man just like Himself, perfect (Matt. 5:48; Col. 1:28).
- (b) God is light, full of glory, splendor, and brilliance of light. Thus God created and clothed man with the glory of His light (John 1:5; Psa. 104:1, 2).

- (c) God is holy: sinless, righteous, pure and moral. Thus God created man holy, sinless, righteous, pure, an moral (Lev. 11:45; 1 Peter 1: 15, 16; Heb. 12:14)
- (d) God is love: devoted, loyal, loving, merciful, gracious, and compassionate. So God created man as a creature of love, devotion, loyalty, mercy, grace and compassion (1 John 4:16).
- (e) God is Spirit, eternal Spirit; God is life, eternal life; God is the only Person who has lived for ever, who never had a beginning and shall never have an ending. God created man and gave him a spirit, an immortal breath, a life that lives forever just like God.
