(a) In general, "**attribute**" is a quality or characteristics given to a person or group or something. Some synonyms are: characteristics, quality, trait, feature, etc.

(b) As "**attributes**" to God (*Briefly noted*): God is a Spirit, infinite, eternal and unchangeable in being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness and truth.

(c) To briefly expand on the above; God's attributes are explained in two groups:

(1) **Unique attributes of God** (*refers to those possess only by God*): omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent, unchangeable, etc.

(2) **Moral attributes of God** (*refers to those that can be experienced by humans but God is at a higher degree, much greater!!*): goodness, love, merciful, gracious, compassionate etc.
