God's Unfailing Comfort

A. Clarification Necessary Isa. 40:27

1. Concealment Challenged
"Why sayest thou ...?" v. 27a
2. Clarification of Status
"... Oh Jacob" or "Oh Israel" v. 27b
3. Contemplating Incorrectly
"My way is hid from the Lord and my judgment is passed over from my God" v. 27c

B. Creators Care and Comfort Unparallel Isa. 40:28a-e

1. Tenet of God (Doctrine of God)
"Hast thou not known" v. 28a
2. Traditional Transmission
"Hast thou not heard" v. 28b
3. Timeless God
"That the everlasting God ..." v. 28c
4. Transcendent Creator/ Sovereign King
"The Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth ..." v. 28d
5. Tenacious Eternally
"Fainteth not, neither is weary?" v. 28e

C. Comprehensive Awareness Isa. 40:28 f

1. All-knowing God
"There is no searching to His understanding" v. 28f
2. All-inclusive Care
"There is no searching to His understanding." V. 28f

D. Consolation Isa. 40:29

1. Weary Invigorated
"He giveth power to the faint ..." v. 29a
2. Weary and Weak Strengthened
"And to them that have no might he increaseth strength" v. 29b

E. Confidence in God Guarantees Continuity Unparallel Isa. 40:30-31

1. Subtle Reality (Difficult to Understand) v. 30
2. Source of Sustenance/The Condition
"But they that wait upon the Lord" v. 31a
3. Strengthened
"... shall renew their strength ..." v. 31b

4. Soar
"... they shall mount up with wings as eagles ..." v. 31c
5. Steadfastly Press Forward
"... they shall run and not be weary; and they shall walk and not faint." V. 31d
